The Teen Scene Project, located inside the Lodi Public Library, was an additional section to the library to cater to teenagers for reading. The project spans approximately 2,000 square feet behind the existing circulation desk, which includes a teen lounge, media room, and two group study rooms.

Unique features of the project include: floor-to-ceiling glass walls, that divides the Teen Scene and Library, book shelves with built in benches, along with a variety of custom made tables and stools.

Additionally, a 950 square foot fully enclosed outdoor courtyard was built where concrete walls hold inset benches covered by mesh awnings to provide shade as well as decorative screens on the walls facing the alleyway behind the library.

Prior to the start of construction, Diede Construction performed value engineering for the City of Lodi to ensure the city received the most out of their budget. The overall savings from the valued engineering saved the city over five percent (5%) with simple and small design changes that made little to no effect to the aesthetics and sustainability of the original design itself.



Diede continued it's excellent track record on fire stations and fire training facilities with this new fire station in the west side of Napa. Completed by an amazing team; Blaine Vernon, Ashlie Reeves, Dale Davidson, and many others to the City of Napa and the Napa Fire Department now have a beautiful Fire Station. The project was estimated at \$4,229,184 with 245 working days.

Due to seismic activity in the Napa area, the station's foundation consists of sixty (60 ea), sixty foot long (60'), twelve inch diameter (12") steel piles. The construction was approximately a 5,145 sqaure foot structure, with parking areas, and driving aisles. The exterior appears to be a residence, Napa Valley Style, with hardie board shingle siding, exposed roof beam outriggers, and redwood fencing and gates.

The project includes finishes and equipment typical to most fire stations; polished concrete floors, skylights, a commercial grade kitchen with stainless steel countertops and backsplash, an exercise room with rubber flooring, ancillary space for the hose dryer, extractor and gear lockers, and an apparatus bay with overhead reels for electrical, water, air, and vehicle exhaust systems.

10162. Disqualification, removal, etc. from federal, state or local government project; questionnaire; rejection of bid.

The department shall require from all prospective bidders the completion, under penalty of perjury, of a standard form of questionnaire inquiring whether such prospective bidder, any officer of such bidder, or any employee of such bidder who has a proprietary interest in such bidder, has ever been disqualified, removed, or otherwise prevented from bidding on, or completing a federal, state, or local government project because of a violation of law of a safety regulation, and if so to explain the circumstances.

A bid may be rejected on the basis of a bidder, any officer of such bidder, or any employee of such bidder who has a proprietary interest in from bidding on, or completing a federal, state, or local project because of a violation of law or a safety regulation.

7028.15. License required to submit bid to public agency; Exceptions.

- (a) It is a misdemeanor for any person to submit a bid to a public agency in order to engage in the business or act in the capacity of a CONTRACTOR within this state without having a license therefore, except in any of the following cases:

- (c) This section shall not apply to a joint venture license, as required by Section 7029.1; however, at the time of making a bid as a joint venture, each person submitting the bid shall be subject to this section with respect to his or her individual licensure.
- (d) This section shall not affect the right or ability of a licensed architect, land surveyor, or registered professional engineer to form joint ventures with licensed CONTRACTOR'S to render services within the scope of their respective practices.
- (e) Unless one of the foregoing exceptions applies, a bid submitted to a public agency by a CONTRACTOR who is not licensed in accordance with this chapter shall be considered non-responsive and shall be rejected by the public agency. The amount of civil penalties, appeal, and finality of such citation shall be subject to Sections 7028.7 to 7028.13, inclusive. Any contract awarded to, or any purchase order issued to, a CONTRACTOR who is not licensed pursuant to this chapter is void.

- (f) Any compliance or non-compliance with subdivision (e) of this section, as added by Chapter 863 of the Statutes of 1989, shall not invalidate any contract or bid awarded by a public agency during which time that subdivision was in effect.
